### New tuition, more accessibility for students

Your tuition is now based on the number of hours you register for each semester. With the exception of the SEAM, if you wish to take fewer hours each semester, now you can. In addition to the plans of study options this offers students (see **Plans of study for 4, 7 & 10 semesters** to compare) we hope this change makes the MAIGC more accessible to students who want to advance their careers with a graduate degree in this fascinating area of communication.

### Personal payment plan and financial aid

All students should have a personal payment plan or financial aid secured before starting the program. Financial aid is available to all students who are U.S. citizens and those who have green cards. Eligible MAIGC students are strongly encouraged to apply for financial aid before starting the program and by April 1 for the fall semester. The second financial aid application, which is filled out at the beginning of the second semester, will award funds for the final semester. **\*KSU tuition and fees:** In-state tuition for Fall 2016 is \$283 per semester hour. University fees per semester are \$853 for students enrolling in fewer than 5 hours and \$1,003 for students taking 5 hours or more. Out-of-state students will pay \$7,524 per semester regardless of the number of hours taken that semester. Like all in-state students, out-of-state students will pay out-of-pocket for textbooks and all SEAM expenses. See **Plans of study for 4, 7 & 10 semesters** to note hours taken each semester. See next page for a breakdown of these expenses by semester. Tuition and fees may increase year to year. University tuition and fees are approved by the Board of Regents on a yearly basis. However, the university may choose to assess additional fees at any time, and you will be responsible for paying this amount.

#### \*\*Textbooks

Estimates shown is for total program. Costs for textbooks vary from semester to semester and professor to professor. Syllabi for your MAIGC courses will list textbooks required for each course, and some will be e-books.

#### \*\*\*SEAM costs

SEAM cost estimates are based on travel and lodging only. These costs vary according to travel destination, type of lodging (ex: hotel versus hostel) and length of stay. This does not consider the cost of personal entertainment or personal excursions, nor food costs. Food costs vary considerably by student, destination and length of stay.
